**Subject:** Board Vacancy

Background

In a letter dated March 20, 2019, Director Kromydas tendered his resignation. As required by Gov. Code 1780, Office Manager Crawford informed county elections of his resignation.

The remaining members of the board may fill the vacancy either by appointment (within 60 days of receipt of notification) or by calling an election to be held on the next established election date that is 130 or more days after the district board calls the election. An appointment may not be made until 15 days after the district posts a notice of the vacancy (provided by county elections) in three conspicuous places in the district.

If the district takes no action then the board of supervisors may appoint a person to fill the vacancy within 90 days of receipt of notification or call the election.

Whether appointed or elected, the new board member will fill the balance of the unexpired term of office which ends December 6, 2020.

Recommendation

Direct staff to post the Notice of Vacancy no less than 15 days prior to the next board meeting (May 22<sup>nd</sup>).
